TAFE graduates fast track their study with Raffles College

TAFE NSW students studying for diplomas in a range of design, fashion and digital media disciplines will now receive credits for their studies when applying for undergraduate degrees at Raffles College of Design and Commerce in North Sydney.

A newly signed articulation agreement between Raffles College and TAFE NSW means the students will have advanced standing into either the Bachelor of Design or Bachelor of Arts (Visual Communication) degrees.

Similarly, TAFE NSW graduates of Graphic Design, Digital Media, 3D Animation and Digital Effects, Screen, Games Artistry, Information and Communication Technology, Multimedia and Photography are eligible to gain advanced standing for Raffles College's Bachelor of Arts (Visual Communication) degree.

CEO of Raffles College, Isaac Ng, said the agreement facilitated the easy movement of students from TAFE NSW programs to Raffles College programs.

"We are very excited about this new articulation pathway for TAFE NSW graduates," Mr Ng said. "TAFE NSW has a terrific reputation for developing potential in students and we hope to be able to continue and advance their good work," he said.

Manager Industry Team, Industry Skills Unit, Ultimo for TAFE NSW, Agnes Vukovic, said the agreement provides a new pathway for TAFE NSW diploma students.
